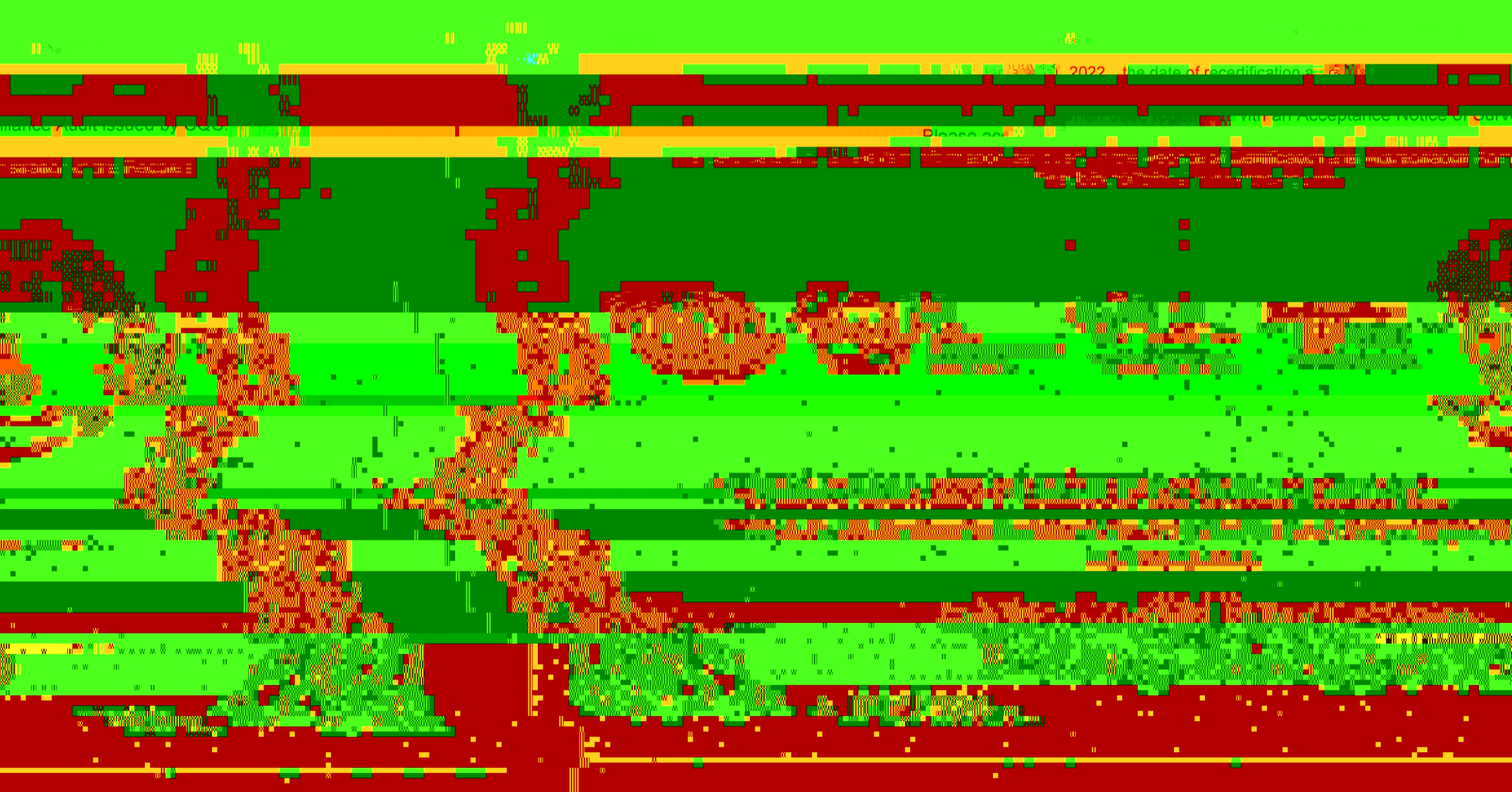
WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT

Section 10 - Discharge of Pollutants

10. (1) No person shall discharge any pollutant into any water body unless he has obtained a discharge licence from the Authority.

(2) The Authority may, if it is satisfied that it is in the public interest, grant a discharge licence to any person who applies for it.

(3) A discharge licence shall be granted to a person only if the Authority is satisfied that the discharge of the pollutant will not be injurious to the public health or the environment.
